

Wesley Township Board Minutes December 14, 2010

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Trustee Tennant led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Road Commissioner Rodawold, Assessor Rodawold, Trustees, Donohue, Gabriel, and Tennant. Absent was Trustee Stetzo.

Several amendments to the minutes were suggested. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the minutes as amended of the November 16, 2010 meeting. Motioned seconded by Trustee Tennant. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$8,365.32. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Tennant seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Vasko presented the Assessor's bills. Trustee Donohue made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Tennant seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Highway Commissioner Rodawold presented the Road district bills of \$2,114.96. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Tennant seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report. He went over correspondence received.

Under Assessor's report, Assessor Rodawold reported that the annual meeting was the following day. Also that some of her stuff will be going on line soon.

Road Commissioner Rodawold gave his report that the International Truck is up and running and the plows are on. Trustee Tennant asked about the salt dome and he replied it was locked in.

There was no Clerk's, Trustees or Land Use Committee report.

Under Park Committee report, Dan reported that the porta-potty has been removed. He also said that it was time to start locking up the park and shut off the boat launch light. He will be moving a the lawnmower.

Under Old Business, the agenda was amended to include the FOIA officer resolution. Trustee Tennant made the motion, Trustee Gabriel seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

A discussion was held as to who would fill the role of FOIA officer for the Road District. It was recommended in November that Joe Rodawold be his own FOIA officer. Road Commissioner Rodawold refused the position. It was pointed out that records had not been forthcoming in many cases, and Clerk Vasko said that she was not willing to fill the role either

for that reason. Questions were then asked about paperwork on the new truck, as to title, contract, insurance, etc. Supervisor Jay said that he would contact TOI what happens if no one wants to be FOIA officer. Clerk Vasko was asked to make a list of paperwork she knows is missing. John Norton volunteered to do the job, and Supervisor Jay said that he would ask TOI about that as well. Trustee Donohue made a motion to table the road district FOIA officer resolution. Trustee Gabriel seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote.

Under New Business Supervisor Jay presented the levies for the Township and Road District. He explained how the numbers were arrived at, and said that we are asking 105% of last year. He said there was virtually not chance we would get it.

Trustee Tennant made a motion to pass the Township Levy as presented with Trustee Donohue making a second. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Trustee Donohue made a motion to pass the Road District Levy, Trustee Gabriel seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Under public comment, Trustee Gabriel requested that salt be spread where Sunset turns into Roberts. She said that from Hamilton to Bass is ice. Highway Commissioner Rodawold said he would look into it. Supervisor Jay said that the roads have been well maintained through the previous snow falls.

Trustee Gabriel made a motion to adjourn at 9:35 p.m., Trustee Tennant seconded. Motion passed by voice vote.
