

Wesley Township Board Minutes June 8, 2010

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:43 p.m. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Trustees, Donohue, Gabriel, Stetzo, and Tennant and Highway Commissioner Rodawold and Assessor Rodawold.

The minutes were reviewed and several errors were noted. Trustee Tennant made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2010 meeting as amended. Motioned seconded by Trustee Donohue. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$8,001.39. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes; Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

The Assessor's bills of \$125 were submitted. Trustee Tennant made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Donohue seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes; Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Highway Commissioner Rodawold presented the Road district bills of \$11,464. 82 Trustee Stetzo made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Donohue seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes; Gabriel – yes; Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report. He went over correspondence received.

There was no Road Commissioner, Assessor or Clerk report.

Under Land Use Committee Report, Ben Galyon reported that in 60 days there would be recommendations.

Under Park Committee report, Kathleen Kennedy reported that the flea market made \$447. The township would be partnering with the Isaac Walton League for a benefit flea market on Saturday, August 28.

Trustee report was given by Trustee Gabriel. She reported on what she and Trustee Tennant learned at the Trustee Conference. They told of ways to make money using the park as a venue. She also told about a grant from IDNR that was available to parks

Under Old Business there was nothing new under office arrangements & title. Under Rival's Lookout Park, Supervisor Jay asked about a Halloween party at the park. Margaret Gabriel and her sister Katie were appointed to the Park Committee. . It was reported that some used fencing was available and a discussion was held as to whether we would accept it. It was decided to look into it. Supervisor Jay reported that the ground was sinking around the pavilion and soil was running into what appears to be a well house. A discussion was held if the Wesley Soldier's Memorial could be moved to the park. Trustee Tennant made a motion to put a path

from the road to the pavilion, Trustee Gabriel seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes; Gabriel – yes; Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Under plaques, Trustee Donohue forgot his father's which will be used as an example.

Trustee Tennant moved that the board go into executive session at 9:00 p.m., Trustee Stetzo seconded it. A voice vote was taken, motion passed.

At 9:15 p.m. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to reopen the regular board meeting, Trustee Tennant seconded. Voice vote was taken, motion passed.

Under public comment John Norton reported that tornado siren in Resthaven at Rival's and Angle was repaired. Secondly he reported that maps of Lakewood Shores do not agree. It seems that Robert Street is wrongly labeled as Roberts Street. Street signs, originally paid for by the Lakewood Shores Association, need to be changed.

Trustee Gabriel moved to adjourn at 9:22 p.m., Trustee Tennant seconded it. A voice vote was taken, motion passed.
