

Minutes from the October 12, 2010 Township Meeting

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Trustees Stetzo and Gabriel. Absent were Trustees Donohue and Tennant, Road Commissioner Rodawold and Assessor Rodawold.

Clerk Vasko presented the minutes from September 2010 meeting. One change was noted. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Motioned seconded by Trustee Stetzo. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$1, 282.46. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Jay – yes. Motion passed.

The Assessor's bills of \$904.81 were submitted. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Jay – yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Vasko presented the Road district bills of \$19,868.21. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Jay – yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report.

Under Clerk's report Clerk Vasko reported that she had received an e-mail from the Illinois Attorney General with the response from the Stachowiak FOIA's. It seems to be a closed matter as far as he as concerned.

There was no Land Use report.

Under Park Committee Supervisor Jay reported that no one showed up at the last Park Meeting. John Norton reported he worked on the fire pit.

There was no Trustee report.

Under Old Business Supervisor Jay read a letter from the IEPA that stated that they firmly rejected the statements in the letter received from the Road District attorney. And they would proceed against him. Clerk Vasko reported that no documentation was ever received at the Hall on this procedure. Supervisor Jay stated that he had told the IEPA that the Township has no responsibility for Road District's business. Terry Frost asked why grindings were being objected to; Jay responded that it was the sandblast material that was in contention.

Clerk Vasko asked if the November meeting could be rescheduled as she and Trustee Stetzo were attending the TOI conference in Springfield. It was decided to reschedule the meeting to November 16, 2010. Motion made by Trustee Gabriel, seconded by Stetzo. Motion passed by voice vote.

There was no public comment.

Trustee Stetzo made a motion to adjourn, Trustee Gabriel seconded it. Voice vote taken, motion passed. Meeting was adjourned at 8:09 p.m..
