

# Wesley Township Board Minutes

June 14, 2016 – 7:53 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:53 p.m. by Supervisor Jay. Trustee Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken by Clerk Vasko. Present were Supervisor Jay, Assesor Garvey, Hwy Commissioner Norton, Clerk Vasko, Trustees Kennedy, Tennant, Smolenski and Spinale.

Under Public Comments, Rich Welchko reported that he had been working with Highway Commissioner Norton to map and locate accurately the water mains in Lakewood Shores. Leonard McCubbin, from the area of Donohue and Danielson, commented about an insurance claim to damage on the tar and chip road; and asked why we haven't pursued that insurance claim. Gary Feil got up to thank Hwy. Commissioner Norton for the work done on Wood Street.

Motion to approve the May 10, 2016 minutes was made by Trustee Tennant, and seconded by Trustee Spinale. Voice vote was taken, motion passed.

The town bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$7,956.12. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Tennant, seconded by Trustee Smolenski. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

The Assessor's bills were presented by Assesor Garvey in the amount of \$2,045.25. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Smolenski, seconded by Trustee Kennedy. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

Road District bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$21,371.01. Trustee Kennedy made a motion to approve, seconded by Trustee Spinale. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

Supervisor Jay reviewed and submitted his financial report.

Highway Commissioner Norton reported on all the streets that he has been working on.

Assesor Garvey reported on the new procedures for the Board of Review.

Under Clerk Report, Clerk Vasko discussed the new bulletin board at Rivals Park.

Under Trustee report, Trustee Spinale reported that the Porta-Potties were full to overflowing, and the company did not respond in a timely matter to do the clean up. Trustee Kennedy reported that there was also a problem with the garbage collection.

Under Park Report, parking, especially for handicapped was discussed. New poles for the volley ball court was also discussed.

Under Old Business, the FY 2017 Township Budget was presented. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Tennant, seconded by Trustee Kennedy. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed. The Wesley Road District FY2017 Budget was presented, motion to approve was made by Trustee Tennant, seconded by Trustee Kennedy. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

Under New Business a motion was made by Trustee Kennedy to table the park committee, seconded by Trustee Tennant. Voice vote was taken, motion passed.

Trustee Kennedy brought up working a booth at Catfish Days in Wilmington on behalf of the Park.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Smolenski, seconded by Trustee Tennant. Motion passed by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 9:30.
