Road commissioner reported checks deposited to bank with paperwork to be submitted to Supervisor, to obtain CDL license, to perform vehicle inspections, obtaining credit card, status of equipment at Ritchie location [two vehicles remain on property], FOIA officer named as Supervisor – Supervisor declined – Road commissioner will remain responsible for FOIA responses submitted to the Road District. Meeting disrupted by member of public during this discussion.
