

Wesley Township Board Minutes

May 10, 2016 – 7 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:08 p.m. by Supervisor Jay. Trustee Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken by Clerk Vasko. Present were Supervisor Jay, Hwy Commissioner Norton, Clerk Vasko, Trustees Kennedy, Tennant, Smolenski and Spinale. Absent was Assessor Garvey.

Motion to approve the April 12, 2016 minutes as amended, was made by Trustee Tennant, and seconded by Trustee Spinale. Voice vote was taken, motion passed.

The town bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$4,251.12. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Spinale, seconded by Trustee Tennant. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

There were no Assessor's bills.

Road District bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$9,842.15. Trustee Tennant made a motion to approve, seconded by Trustee Smolenski. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

Under Public Comments, Marsha Keller from Thelma Drive asked if there was any opposition to putting up a "children at play" sign. The township said that they couldn't put up a sign themselves, but a sign on her own private property would be allowed. Rich Welchko asked if he could rent the pavilion on July 29.

Supervisor Jay reviewed and submitted his financial report.

Highway Commissioner Norton reported that a change in the law governing surplus equipment had recently been made.

Dan Jay reported that Assessor Garvey said that they are finishing up the 2016 assessments.

Under Clerk Report, Clerk Vasko reported that a public hearing could not be held in May as there was only 20 days to notify the public. The public hearing on the budgets would be held at the June 14 meeting. She then reported on the search for a bulletin board.

There was no Trustee Report

Under Park Report, Trustee Kennedy reported that the well was shocked and tested. The pavilion in the park was repaired, a urinal in the porta-potty was needed, and the arches have been painted and will be put in the park for photographs. She also reported that signage for the disc golf course needs to be updated. Trustee Spinale reported that he had an estimate for the tees on the disc golf at \$2,300. He also gave an estimate on PVC downspouts on both sides of the pavilion at \$300 a side.

Under old business the town budget was reviewed and no changes were made. The road district budget was discussed and changes made.

Under new business a discussion was held about a park committee and tabled until it can be put on the agenda in June.

Motion to adjourn was made by Kennedy, seconded by Trustee Spinale. Motion passed by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:35.
