

Wesley Township Board Minutes

October 11, 2016 – 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jay. Assessor Garvey led the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken by Clerk Vasko. Present were Supervisor Jay, Hwy Commissioner Norton, Assessor Garvey, Clerk Vasko, Trustees Kennedy, Smolenski, Spinale and Tennant.

Under public comment the Marcia and Bill Keller commented on what a good experience they had with Bobbie, the care taker of Rivals Lookout Park. They praised his attitude and his willingness to help.

Motion to approve the September 14, 2016 minutes was made by Trustee Spinale and seconded by Trustee Kennedy. Voice vote was taken, motion passed.

The town bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$3,352.50. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Smolenski and seconded by Trustee Tennant. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes; Trustee Tennant, yes. Motion passed.

The Assessor's bills were presented by Assessor Garvey in the amount of \$258.00. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Tennant and seconded by Trustee Smolenski. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes; Trustee Tennant, yes. Motion passed.

Road District bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$3,623.57. Trustee Spinale made a motion to approve and seconded by Trustee Kennedy. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

Supervisor Jay submitted and reviewed his financial report.

Highway Commissioner Norton reported that IDOT had given the asphalt grindings from the repairs on Rt. 102 to Wesley Township.

Under Assessor Report, Assessor Garvey report she had 4 residential appeals that were received.

Under Clerk Report, Clerk Vasko reported that candidates' petitions were available for the 2017 Consolidated Election. She commented that the information on the township website was out of date and it needed to be corrected. Also that the November meeting will be held on Wednesday November 9, instead of a Tuesday.

There was no Trustee report.

Under Park Report, Trustee Kennedy reported that several people had volunteered at the park, Bobbie had done maintenance on the mower, and vandalism had happened at the park - holes in the volleyball net and a pin missing from the boat dock.. She also reported that an incident happened on September 27 which

resulted in a police report. She requested an official report in writing barring the individual. In addition insulting e-mails were also received. Since this was not on the agenda, no vote could be made and the issue was continued until the next meeting.

There was no Old Business.

There was no New Business.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Smolenski, seconded by Trustee Spinale. Motion passed by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 7:35.
