

Wesley Township Board Minutes

September 13, 2016 – 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Supervisor Jay. Supervisor Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken by Clerk Vasko. Present were Supervisor Jay, Hwy Commissioner Norton, Assessor Garvey, Clerk Vasko, Trustees Kennedy, Smolenski, Spinale and Tennant.

There was no public comments.

Motion to approve the Aug 9, 2016 minutes as amended was made by Trustee Kennedy and seconded by Trustee Smolenski. Voice vote was taken, motion passed.

The town bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$3,476.10. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Smolenski and seconded by Trustee Tennant. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes; Trustee Tennant, yes. Motion passed.

The Assessor's bills were presented by Assessor Garvey in the amount of \$459.00. Motion to approve was made by Trustee Tennant and seconded by Trustee Smolenski. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes; Trustee Tennant, yes. Motion passed.

Road District bills were presented by Clerk Vasko in the amount of \$8,590.30. Trustee Spinale made a motion to approve and seconded by Trustee Tennant. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

Supervisor Jay submitted and reviewed his financial report.

Assessor Garvey reported that she has had no complaints on the portal and that she had scheduled 12 meetings with seniors applying for their exemption.

Highway Commissioner Norton reported that he had purchased a large amount of tools. He said that work would soon begin on 102 widening the shoulders, adding rumble strips and reflectors in the middle. He reported on various roads around the township that has received his attention in the last month.

Under Assessor Report, Assessor Garvey report that that the multiplier for Wesley Township 1.0555. The assessment notices were sent out July 29 and the appeal deadline is September 6th. She also explained all the new ways of dealing with protesting taxes, and the various deadlines associated with it.

Under Clerk Report, Clerk Vasko reported that the TOI conference was coming up and those who wished to attend should let her know.

There was no Trustee report.

Under Park Report, Trustee Kennedy asked for a better map of the park to help decide parking areas, disk golf, camping areas, etc. Supervisor Jay informed that she could use the County GIS maps on line, or perhaps Google maps. Trustee Spinale asked about a refund for Rich Welcho for a deposit on the park he had made. She reported about the new golf league, number of people banned from the park, and Ace Hardware donated 5 mums. She also reported that the Little Library in the Park was up and needed to be filled with books.

Under Old Business, Supervisor Jay reviewed the plan for a new Park Committee. After lengthy discussion Supervisor Jay made a motion to table the discussion until the January 2017 meeting, motion seconded by Trustee Spinale. Roll call vote was taken, Trustee Tennant, yes; Trustee Smolenski, yes; Trustee Kennedy yes; Trustee Spinale, yes. Motion passed.

There was no New Business.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Spinale, seconded by Trustee Tennant. Motion passed by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:24.
