

Wesley Township Board Minutes August 9, 2011 – 7:00 p.m.

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:02p.m. Supervisor Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Road Commissioner Rodawold, Trustees Stetzo and Tennant. Absent was Assessor Roadwold, Trustees Donohue and Gabriel.

There were no public comments.

Trustee Stetzo made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 12, 2011 meeting. Motioned seconded by Trustee Tennant. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$2,665.70. Motion made by Trustee Stetzo to approve the bills, motion seconded by Trustee Tennant. Assessor's bills were presented totally \$316.90 Roll call vote was taken, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes, Jay - yes. Motion passed.

Road Commissioner Rodawold presented the Road district bills of \$28,000.12. Trustee Tennant made a motion to approve the bills. Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes, Jay - yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report. He also commented that in the correspondence was another letter from the Illinois Environmental Protection agency stated that they were continuing their suit against both the Wesley Township Road District and the Township of Wesley itself.

Under Road Commissioners report, he reported various places where tar and chip were put down.

There was no Assessor's, Clerk's, or Land Use report.

Under Park Report, Dan Jay reported that the volley ball had been installed. He said that a lot of trimming had been done and the fencing had been put up to create a little area to store things.

There was no Trustees report.

There was no old or new business.

Clerk Vasko commented on the fact that the report from the Senior Services Agency listed 89 people from Wesley being served, but Wesley had not contributed any money to them.

Trustee Tennant made a motion to adjourn at 7:41 p.m., Trustee Stetzo seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote.
