

## **Wesley Township Board Minutes February 14, 2012– 7:00 p.m.**

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Trustees Donohue, Stetzo and Gabriel. Absent were Road Commissioner and Assessor Rodawold, Trustees Tennant.

Under Public Comments, Matt Smolenski reported that the bridge over Forked Creek at Leasure Road had been spray painted with some sort of graffiti. He wondered if the Road Commissioner would do something about it.

Trustee Donohue made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 13, 2011 meeting. Motioned seconded by Trustee Stetzo. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$3,596.79. Motion made by Trustee Donohue to approve the bills, motion seconded by Trustee Stetzo. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Vasko presented the Assessor's bills totaling \$754.00. Trustee Stetzo made a motion to approve the Assessor's bills, Trustee Donohue seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo - yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Vasko presented the Road District bills totaling 15,294.78.

A representative from CASA then came in. She had been on the agenda after Public Comments, but had gotten lost. The regular meeting was paused so that she could speak to us about the work the CASA does, which is help young people in the Court System. She asked that Wesley Township consider giving the group a donation. The board thanked her and said they would consider it.

The regular meeting was then resumed. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the Road District bills pending the receipt of a signed labor statement from Road Commissioner Rodawold. Trustee Stetzo seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report.

There was no Highway Commissioners or Assessor's Report.

Under Clerk's Report Clerk Vasko talked about the need for all Trustees to pass an on-line course about the Open Meetings Act, and FOIA Officer Act if that applied.

There was no Trustee's report.

Under Land Use Report, Supervisor Jay reported that the changes that have taken place at the County level make a Land Use committee no longer useful, and that we should find out if it is worth having a Land Use Committee at all.

Under Park Report, Supervisor Jay and John Norton discussed various plans for Rivals Park, and that the gate was to remain closed for the time being so that vehicles would not tear up the grass.

There was no Old Business.

There was no New Business.

Trustee Stetzo made a motion to adjourn at 8:31 p.m., Trustee Gabriel seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote.
