

## **Wesley Township Board Minutes July 9, 2013 – 7:00 p.m.**

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. Supervisor Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Gabriel, Assessor Rodawold, Trustees Galyon, Jessen, Kennedy and Tennant, absent Road Commissioner Stickel.

There was no public comment.

Trustee Galyon made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2013 public hearing meeting for the town budget. Motioned seconded by Trustee Tennant, motion passed by voice vote.

Trustee Galyon made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2013 public hearing for the Road District budget. Motion seconded by Trustee Jessen, motion passed by voice vote.

Trustee Tennant made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2013 meeting. Motion seconded by Trustee Galyon, motion passed by voice vote.

Clerk Gabriel presented the Township bills totaling \$3676.41. Motion made by Trustee Galyon to approve the bills, motion seconded by Trustee Tennant. Roll call vote was taken, Galyon – yes; Jessen-yes; Kennedy– yes; Tennant – yes; Jay - yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Gabriel presented the Assessor's bills from June 2013 totaling \$875.5. Trustee Galyon made a motion to approve the Assessor's bills, Trustee Tennant seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Galyon – yes; Jessen– yes;; Kennedy– yes Tennant – yes; Jay – yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Gabriel presented the Road District's bills totaling \$15,072.57. This included the return of Lee Werner's bond, which totaled \$10,000. Trustee Kennedy made a motion to approve the Road bills. Trustee Galyon seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Galyon – yes; Jessen– yes; Kennedy– yes; Tennant – yes; Jay – yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Supervisor Jay gave his attached report.

There was no Highway Commissioner's report.

There was no Assessor's report.

Under Land Use report there was a discussing regarding the use of aerial views of land used to asses properties.

Under Park report Supervisor Jay reported on the "Catfish Days" fishing tournament and a Glow Disc Golf Tournament that will be held on Saturday, July 27. It was also recommended that there be envelopes down at the park for people to put their money in for the boat ramp and camping.

Under Clerk's report, Clerk Gabriel said that the Township had been served with a summons regarding the accident on Ballou Road. This summons was forwarded to the attorney. She also stated that everyone needs to do their FOI online and turn the certificate in. Mail boxes were put up for everyone's mail and paperwork to be put into.

Under Trustee's report the November conference was discussed as to who was attend or might be attending. Hotels rooms were being reserved now for those wanting to attend.

Under new business Clerk Gabriel presented the Prevailing Wage Act. This act is just showing that the township will pay prevailing wage on jobs. Trustee Galyon made the motion to adopt the Prevailing Wage Act. Trustee Kennedy seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken, Galyon – yes; Jessen– yes;; Kennedy– yes Tennant – yes; Jay – yes. Motion passed.
