

Wesley Township Board Minutes June 14, 2011

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 8:07 p.m. Supervisor Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Road Commissioner Rodawold, Trustees Donohue, Gabriel, Stetzo, and Tennant. Absent was Assessor Roadwold.

There were no public comments.

Trustee Donohue made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 10, 2011 meeting. Motioned seconded by Trustee Stetzo. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$14,624.41. Motion made by Trustee Stetzo to approve the bills, motion seconded by Trustee Gabriel. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

There were no Assessor's bills.

Road Commissioner Rodawold presented the Road district bills of \$20,790.83. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the bills. Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report.

Highway Commissioner Rodawold reported that the pilot project using a special road mix for a four year test through Prairie Materials was completed. He said that his crew was busy filling pot holes, and that the drainage project he was working on was so far successful.

There was no Assessor's or Clerk's report.

Under Park Report, it was announced that the Park Committee had lost most of its members and new people would have to be found. Supervisor Jay reported that the Disk golf course was set out, but the tees were yet to be installed. Also the volleyball equipment had arrived.

Under Land Use Report, it was announced that the Land Use Committee had not met in quite a long time. And, since there were many land use issues to be dealt with, a new committee would have to be formed.

Under Old business, Trustee Gabriel made a motion to add both the township budgets to the agenda, Trustee Donohue seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote. The proposed Township budget was reviewed as amended in the Public Hearing. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the budget, Trustee Stetzo seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes, Jay - yes. Motion passed.

The Road District budget was reviewed as amended at the Public Hearing. Trustee Tennant made a motion to approve, Trustee Donohue seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes, Jay - yes. Motion passed.

Under New Business the rules and regulations for Rivals Lookout Park were reviewed. It was agreed that campers would be allowed under the same rules as tent camping. Trustee Gabriel made the motion, Trustee Stetzo seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented a petition for reimbursement for her cell phone bills at the rate of \$25 per month. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the reimbursement at that rate. Trustee Tennant seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes, Jay – yes. Motion passed.
