

Wesley Township Board Minutes November 8, 2011

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. Trustee Tennant led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Trustees, Donohue, Gabriel, Tennant and Stetzo. Absent were Highway Commissioner Rodawold, Assessor Rodawold and Trustee Donohue.

There was no Public comment.

Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 11, 2011 meeting. Motioned seconded by Trustee Stetzo. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills amounting to \$1,007.84. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to pay the township bills as presented. Trustee Donohue seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Trustee Gabriel presented the Assessor's bills amounting to 2,796.45. Trustee Gabriel asked how much was left in the Assessor's budget for payroll. Supervisor Jay said that it was still below the budget. Trustee Stetzo made a motion to approve the bills, Trustee Donohue seconded it. Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Clerk Vasko presented the Road District bills amounting to \$1,929.47. Trustee Gabriel made a motion to approve the Road District bills, Trustee Stetzo seconded it. . Roll call vote was taken, Donohue – yes, Gabriel – yes, Stetzo – yes, Tennant – yes. Motion passed.

Supervisor Jay said that due to his attendance at the TOI conference, his monthly report for November would be available at the next meeting. He did go over the correspondence received. He said that the two Wesley Township voting precincts were consolidated into one, at the Church in Lakewood Shores. He also reported Joe, Margaret, Wanda, Sandy and himself attended the TOI conference.

There was no Road Commissioner, Clerk, Land Use or Assessor's report.

Under Park Report, Kathleen Kennedy said that the porta-johns have been removed. She said that there was less vandalism this year than last. Trustee Gabriel reported that \$25,000 worth of paver bricks were donated by Loewe's. She also reported that we put the Township name on a portable sink for use at the park at the Federal surplus storage facility.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Gabriel at 7:56 p.m. Motion seconded by Trustee Donohue. Motion passed by voice vote.
