

Wesley Township Board Minutes September 13, 2011 – 7:00 p.m.

Supervisor Jay called the meeting to order at 7:02p.m. Supervisor Jay led the pledge of allegiance. Present were Supervisor Jay, Clerk Vasko, Road Commissioner Rodawold, Trustees Donohue and Stetzo. Absent were Assessor Roadwold, Trustees Gabriel and Tennant.

There were no public comments.

Trustee Donohue made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 9, 2011 meeting. Motioned seconded by Trustee Stetzo. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Clerk Vasko presented the Township bills totaling \$9,806.71, which included Assessor's bills. Motion made by Trustee Stetzo to approve the bills, motion seconded by Trustee Donohue. Roll call vote was taken, Stetzo – yes, Donohue– yes, Jay - yes. Motion passed.

Road Commissioner Rodawold presented the Road district bills of \$2,486.65. Trustee Donohue made a motion to approve the bills. Trustee Stetzo seconded. Roll call vote was taken, Stetzo – yes, Donohue – yes, Jay - yes. Motion passed.

Under the Supervisor's report, Dan Jay gave his attached report. He also reported that the issue of flat tires on park equipment should be fixed. He reported that in the previous month there were 3 outings in Rivals Lookout Park which resulted in just under \$500 income.

Under Road Commissioners report, he reported various checks written to the Township. Terry Frost reported that he met the EPA accidently and they said everything looked fine now. Also everything that was objected to has been hauled away. He reported that a patcher came out for a demo, so we received a mile worth of free patching on Ballou Road, Symerton Road and a few other places.

There was no Assessor's, Clerk's report.

Under Land Use Report, Supervisor Jay reported that he has asked Dennis Spears to come back and head up the Land Use Committee. He will ask him to implement the last Land Use Plan.

Under Park Report, Kathleen Kennedy asked that the board consider charging a fee for garbage clean-up. She thought \$50 would be about right. Joe Rodawold thought that \$100 would be better. A discussion ensued about what amount would be right. Jay reported that several problems happened to the park equipment, including a clutch problem. He said that he had two requests for events at the Park in October. Trustee Donohue asked about insurance coverage at the Park. He also said that he was told that we were to have a separate budget for the Park. Supervisor Jay replied that TOIRMA fully covered us, and that since we do not have a separate park district, so therefore we did not have to have a separate budget.

There was no Trustees report.

Under Old Business, a discussion was held as to who wanted to attend the Annual TOI Conference in Springfield.

Under New Business, after a short discussion Supervisor Jay made a motion to table the proposed garbage fees for Rivals Lookout Park to next month. Trustee Stetzo seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote.

Trustee Stetzo made a motion to adjourn at 8:29 p.m., Trustee Donohue seconded it. Motion passed by voice vote.
